Access: IsNull Function

In Access, the **IsNull** function returns TRUE if the expression is a null value. Otherwise, it returns FALSE.

The syntax for the **IsNull** function is:

IsNull (expression)

expression is a variant that contains a string or numeric value.

For example:

IsNull (null) would return TRUE
IsNull ("Tech on the Net") would return FALSE

VBA Code

The **IsNull** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

Dim LValue As Boolean

LValue = IsNull("Tech on the Net")

In this example, the variable called LValue would contain FALSE as a value.

SQL/Queries

You can also use the IsNull function in a query.
