

Access: IsNumeric Function

In Access, the **IsNumeric** function returns TRUE if the expression is a valid number. Otherwise, it returns FALSE.

The syntax for the **IsNumeric** function is:

IsNumeric (expression)

expression is a variant.

For example:

IsNumeric (786)	would return TRUE
IsNumeric ("Tech on the Net")	would return FALSE
IsNumeric ("234")	would return TRUE

VBA Code

The **IsNumeric** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LValue As Boolean
```

```
LValue = IsNumeric("Tech on the Net")
```

In this example, the variable called LValue would contain FALSE as a value.

SQL/Queries

You can also use the **IsNumeric** function in a query.
