

Access: CDbI Function

Question: How do I convert a value to a double?

Answer: To convert a value to a double, use the "CDbl" function. The syntax for the CDbI function is:

CDbl(expression)

For example:

```
Dim LDouble As Double
```

```
LDouble = CDbI(8.45 * 0.005 * 0.01)
```

The variable called LDouble would now contain the value of 0.0004225.
