

Access: Year Function

In Access, the **Year** function returns a four-digit year (a number from 1900 to 9999) given a date value.

The syntax for the **Year** function is:

Year (date_value)

date_value is a valid date.

For example:

Year
(#22/11/2003#) would return 2003

Year
(#01/01/1998#) would return 1998

VBA Code

The **Year** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LYear As Integer
```

```
LYear = Year(#12/03/2001#)
```

In this example, the variable called LYear would now contain the value of 2001.

SQL/Queries

You can also use the **Year** function in a query.
