

Access: ChDir Statement

In Access, the **ChDir** statement allows you to change the current directory or folder.

The syntax for the **ChDir** function is:

ChDir path

path is the path that you'd like to set the current directory to.

Note:

The **ChDir** lets you change the current directory on the current drive. If you need to change drives, try using the [ChDrive statement](#) first.

For example:

ChDir "C:\instructions"	would set the current directory to C:\instructions
ChDir	would set the current directory to
"C:\Documents\Supplies"	C:\Documents\Supplies

VBA Code

The **ChDir** statement can be used in VBA code. For example:

ChDir "C:\instructions"

In this example, the current directory would now be changed to C:\instructions.
