

Access: Abs Function

In Access, the **Abs** function returns the absolute value of a number.

The syntax for the **Abs** function is:

Abs (number)

number is a numeric value.

For example:

Abs (-210.67) would return 210.67

Abs (-2.9) would return 2.9

Abs (-3) would return 3

VBA Code

The **Abs** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LNumber As Double
```

```
LNumber = Abs (-210.6)
```

In this example, the variable called LNumber would now contain the value of 210.6.

SQL/Queries

You can also use the **Abs** function in a query.
