

Access: Exp Function

In Access, the **Exp** function returns e raised to the nth power, where $e = 2.71828183$.

The syntax for the **Exp** function is:

Exp (number)

number is the power to raise e to.

For example:

Exp (3) would return 20.085536923

Exp (3.1) would return 22.197951281

Exp (-3) would return 0.0497870684

VBA Code

The **Exp** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LNumber As Double
```

```
LNumber = Exp(3)
```

In this example, the variable called LNumber would now contain the value of 20.085536923.

SQL/Queries

You can also use the **Exp** function in a query.
