

# Access: Fix Function

---

In Access, the **Fix** function returns the integer portion of a number.

The syntax for the **Fix** function is:

Fix ( expression )

*expression* is a numeric expression whose integer portion is returned.

Note:

If the *expression* is negative, the **Fix** function will return the first negative number that is greater than or equal to the *expression*.

For example:

Fix (210.67)            would return 210

Fix (2.98)             would return 2

Fix (-2.98)            would return -2

## VBA Code

The **Fix** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LNumber As Double
```

```
LNumber = Fix (210.67)
```

In this example, the variable called LNumber would now contain the value of 210.

## SQL/Queries

You can also use the **Fix** function in a query.
