

Access: Right Function

In Access, the **Right** function extracts a substring from a string starting from the right-most character.

The syntax for the **Right** function is:

Right (text, number_of_characters)

Text is the string that you wish to extract from.

Number_of_characters indicates the number of characters that you wish to extract starting from the right-most character.

For example:

Right ("Tech on the Net", 3) would return "Net"

Right ("Alphabet", 5) would return "habet"

VBA Code

The **Right** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LResult As String
```

```
LResult = Right ("Alphabet",3)
```

The variable LResult would now contain the value of "bet".

SQL/Queries

You can also use the **Right** function in a query.
