

Access: Str Function

In Access, the **Str** function returns a string representation of a number.

The syntax for the **Str** function is:

Str (number)

number is the value to convert to a string.

For example:

Str (12) would return " 12".

Str (450) would return " 450"

VBA Code

The **Str** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LResult As String
```

```
LResult = Str (16)
```

In this example, the variable called LResult would now contain the value " 16".

SQL/Queries

You can also use the **Str** function in a query.
