

Access: Trim Function

In Access, the **Trim** function removes leading and trailing spaces from a string.

The syntax for the **Trim** function is:

Trim (text)

text is the string that you wish to remove spaces from.

For example:

Trim (" Tech on the Net") would return "Tech on the Net"

Trim (" Alphabet ") would return "Alphabet"

VBA Code

The **Trim** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LResult As String
```

```
LResult = Trim (" Alphabet ")
```

The variable LResult would now contain the value of "Alphabet".

SQL/Queries

You can also use the **Trim** function in a query.
