

# Access: UCase Function

---

In Access, the **UCase** function converts a string to all upper-case.

The syntax for the **UCase** function is:

UCase ( text )

*text* is the string that you wish to convert to upper-case.

For example:

UCase ("Tech on the Net") would return "TECH ON THE  
NET"

UCase ("Alphabet") would return "ALPHABET"

## VBA Code

The **UCase** function can be used in VBA code. For example:

```
Dim LResult As String
```

```
LResult = UCase ("This is a TEST")
```

In this example, the variable called LResult would now contain the value "THIS IS A TEST".

## SQL/Queries

You can also use the **UCase** function in a query.
